Carol Varner – Vice-President, River City Community Players

 - Parks and Recreation Administrative Office Move Waiting for Sands to finalize some numbers. Hope to take to the City Commission on June 11. Jeff Porter asked about funding for the office move. There is a not to exceed amount of \$385,000 in the 2024 CIP for this project.
 - Sidewalk Replacement in Various Parks Completed work at Haymarket, David Brewer, 10th Avenue Park, Arborway, and Landing Park and parking lot.
 - **Sportsfield Trail/Access Road Replacement** Almost complete, asphalt and concrete are in place, just need some grading and seeding done.
- Cody Park Sports Court Replacement Sands may be pouring concrete on May 14. About 325 yards of concrete for the pickleball court area. Hoping to pour the basketball court later this week. Very happy with how the work is progressing. Jeff Porter asked questions about materials being used and the state of the parking lot now versus when the project is over. The City built in work for the parking lot knowing that the heavy equipment would take a toll.
- Naming of Skatepark "Cody James Clark Skatepark" Thanks to everyone who attended the ceremony. Had great weather and a great turnout. Later that afternoon, met with Dillon Lopez who is adopting the skate park and will help maintain the area.

- **Skatepark Expansion Project** Requests for bids will go out soon for expansion to the east of the current skatepark. Dave Davis asked about the possibility of adding a new skatepark in the south part of town for those residents. Steve Grant explained that would be a great deal more money than expanding what we have now.

Board Input – Jennifer Tobey asked about being able to add a pump track in the skatepark area if grant money were available to pay for it. Jennifer explained what a pump track is and she will possibly help write the grant request for the project. Steve Grant suggested she send him information of what she would like to see and how she proposes to fund it, and staff will review to see if we can do this.
