

CODY PARK PICKLEBALL COURT POLICIES

- Use pickleball courts at your own risk.
- Courts are available on a first come, first served basis from 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. except when reserved by the City of Leavenworth Parks and Recreation Department.
- No pets allowed within the fenced pickleball facility.
- No food or glass within the pickleball facility.
- No alcoholic beverages permitted in the park area without a city issued permit.
- When others are waiting to play, please be courteous. If conflict arises, call the police non-emergency line: 913-682-4411.
- No lessons, leagues, or tournaments without prior approval of the City of Leavenworth Parks and Recreation Department.
- Courts are for pickleball play only --- no skateboards, bicycles, rollerblades, roller-skates, scooters, frisbees, baseball/softballs, soccer balls, etc.
- No wheeled items --- i.e. ball carts, wagons, coolers, etc. --- ADA approved equipment shall be allowed in the pickleball facility.
- Proper athletic attire (shirt, pants, and shoes) are required at all times. Only non-spiked athletic shoes with non-marking soles may be worn when using the courts.
- Let the USA Pickleball (usapickleball.org) rules and policies be your guide.
- When courts are full, the following policies will be followed:
 - Waiting players will place their paddles in the paddle rack provided from left to right;
 - Upon removing paddles from the paddle rack, the "slide pointer" should be slid to the next set of paddles;
 - An individual may not hold a court when players are waiting;
 - Double stacking of paddles in the paddle rack is not permitted;
 - Court time is limited to the best of three games to 11 points. First to 11 points wins --- no "win by 2" policy;
 - Warm-up is limited to five minutes prior to the first game;
 - Exit court immediately following your deciding game. To play again, place your paddles in the paddle rack.
- Lights:
 - Available during regular park hours, 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.
 - Come on for one hour when buttons are pushed.
 - Turn off 15 minutes after orange strobe lights on light poles begin to flash.
 - Push buttons again to restart.
