FERTILIZE RESPONSIBLY

Use slow-release, phosphorous-free products

to reduce the frequency of application. Organic products release slowly and have fewer metals.

Don't apply within 75 feet of waterways. Otherwise, fertilizer will end up in the Missouri River.

Fertilize the lawn, not the sidewalks.

Sweep up excess fertilizer from sidewalks and gutters.

Don't fertilize before a storm.

It will most likely wash away.

Don't feed the storm drain.

Excess pesticides, fertilizer, grass clippings, leaves, and other debris get carried directly into our waterways.
